SECRETARY'S REPORT

On reflection, the 1991/92 season was a period of mixed fortunes. At a club level, teams were competitive in all grades, and two sides performed well enough to earn a berth in the C.M.C.A. finals. A total of seventy-two players represented the club throughout the season, and there were many individual highlights, not the least of which included the new record of career games set by Noel Dettman, and Lindsay Marshall's first catch. There were some disappointments, however, and the forfeit given by the Fifth Eleven in the second round was perhaps the hadir of the season. In this context, the large number of players who were unable to make themselves available for the majority of games created enormous problems for the Selection Committee, and weakened the performances of teams in all grades. Off the field, the club continued to run relatively smoothly, and most social functions were generally well attended, a fitting reward for the efforts of players and supporters alike. I would also like to acknowledge the valuable support given by those members who served on sub-committees, acted as delegates, delivered press reports, transported matting, worked in the canteen, cleaned the rooms, compiled statistics, organized barbeques, and performed a range of duties without which the club could not have functioned in an efficient manner, and maintained its reputation as a leading club in the C.M.C.A. I trust that this level of support will continue in the future as members strive to improve our performance both on and off the field.
